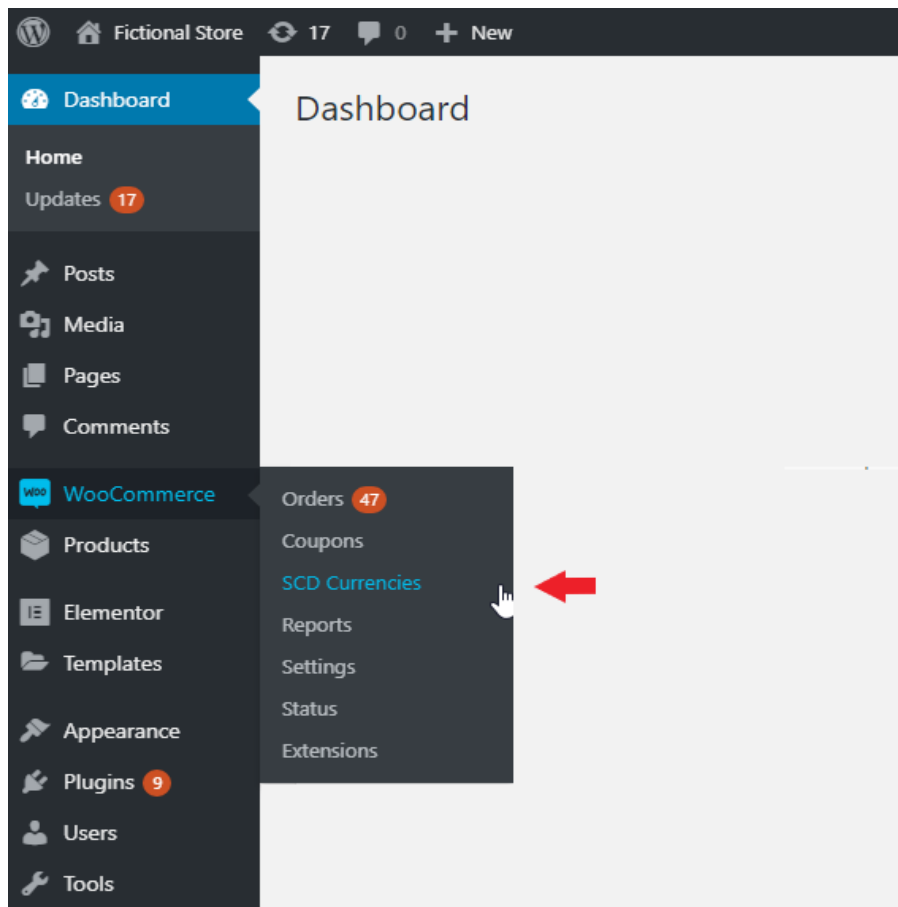

SCD Admin Settings

Accessing the SCD Admin Settings

The SCD admin settings can be accessed from the wordpress admin dashboard page: In the left pane menu of the dashboard go to WooCommerce then SCD currencies.

Delete settings when plugin is uninstalled

Setting	Description

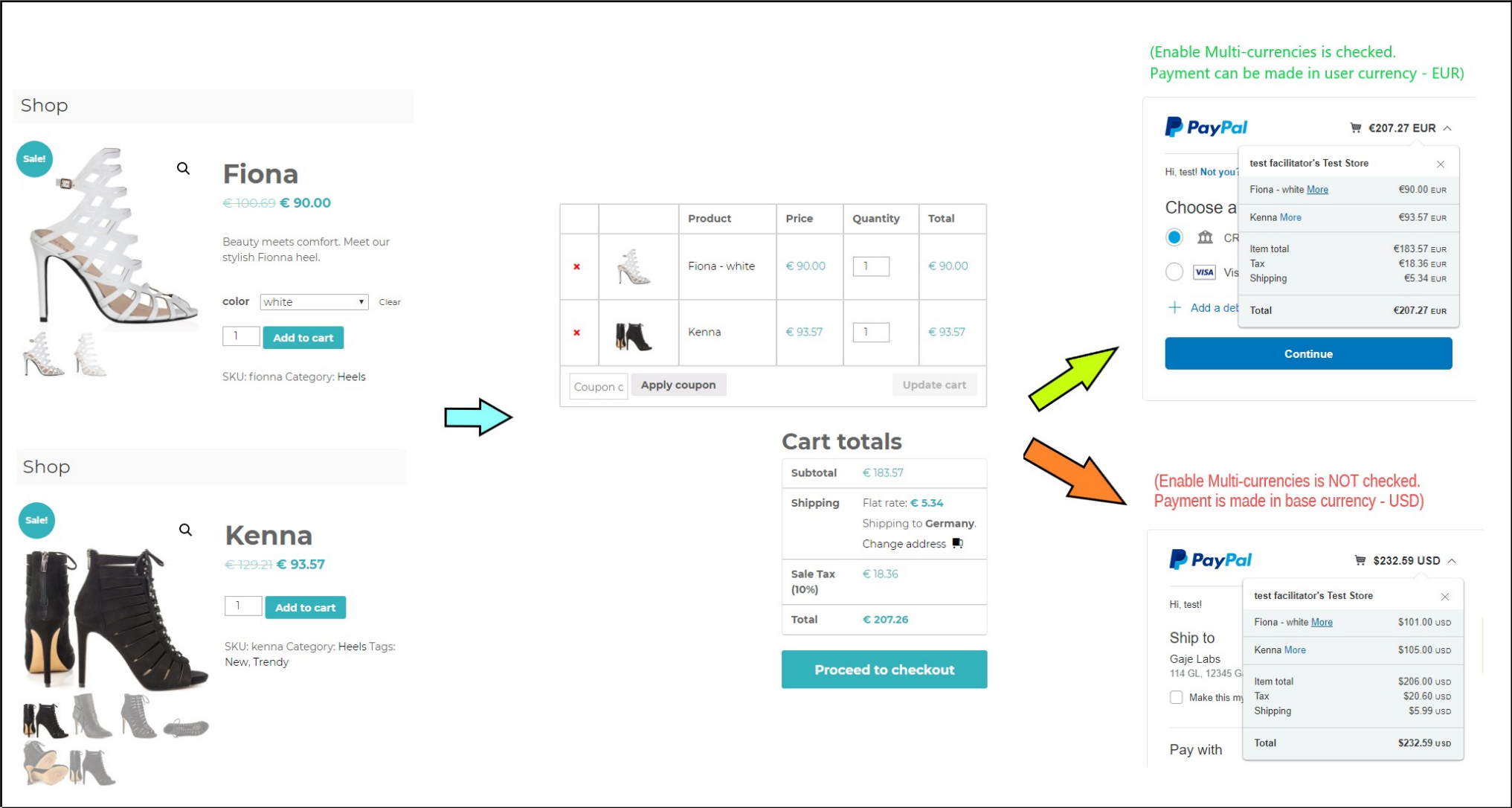


Figure 1: Enable Multiple Currencies Payment

<p><i>Enable multiple currencies payment</i></p>	<p>This setting enables or disables the use of multiple currencies for checkout and payments.</p> <p>When this setting is enabled: Checkout and payment will be made in the selected currency using the converted product prices, for supported payment gateways.</p> <p>When this setting is disabled: SCD will convert the product prices displayed on the shop and product pages; however, all payments will be made in the <i>base currency</i> using the unconverted product prices.</p> <p>Note: <i>base currency</i> refers to the shop currency set in the WooCommerce setting</p> <p>View Example on Figure 1</p>
<p><i>Automatically update the exchange rate</i></p>	<p>This setting enables or disables automatic update of the exchange rate.</p> <p>When this setting is enabled: SCD will update the currency exchange rates used for currency conversion at the rate specified in the setting “Update intervals”.</p> <p>When this setting is disabled: SCD will not update the currency exchange rates.</p>
<p><i>Update intervals</i></p>	<p>This setting indicates the intervals for automatic updates of the currencies exchange rates. The interval can be specified in hours or days.</p>
<p><i>Customize currency options and exchange rates</i></p>	<p>This setting allows you to change the default options for a currency. It allows you to manually specify the exchange rate to use for a currency, the additional percentage to apply on top of the exchange rate, or the currency symbol to display for the currency.</p> <p>When this setting is enabled: You can use the Manual Currency Options setting to specify custom options for the currencies of your choice.</p> <p>When this setting is disabled: The default options will be used for all currencies</p>

Setting	Description
<i>Manual currency options</i>	<p>Add each currency for which you want to manually specify the exchange rate, a percentage based price increase, or the display format. For currencies not included in the table, the normal exchange rate and default display format will be used</p> <p>View description on Figure 2</p>
<i>Delete settings when plugin is uninstalled</i>	<p>This setting indicates if the plugin data and plugin settings should be completely deleted when the plugin is uninstalled. The default value is to delete all data. If you want to be able to reinstall the plugin and recover all your settings, uncheck this setting.</p> <p>When this setting is enabled: Uninstalling the plugin will delete all plugin data including all your custom settings.</p> <p>When this setting is disabled: Plugin data and custom settings will not be deleted when the plugin is uninstalled.</p>

Customize currency options and exchange rates

Manual currency options Default currency: XAF

Add a new currency to the list

For each currency, you can specify: the exchange rate to apply, a percentage increase to add on top of the exchange rate, a custom currency symbol to display and the symbol position. You can leave the Rate or Symbol box empty to use the normal exchange rate or the default currency symbol.


Currency	Rate	Increase	Symbol	Position

This is the list of of currencies for which the user has defined a custom exchange rate or display options. For currencies not included in this list the normal exchange rate and default display options are used.

Setting	Description
<p><i>Select currency based on user location</i></p>	<p>This setting enables the use of geolocation to determine the currency to use for a customer. If enabled, you can use the setting “<i>Filter currencies enabled for your store</i>” to limit the set of currencies available for your store.</p> <p>When this setting is enabled: The user currency used for display and payment will be determined based on the user location and the list of currencies enabled for the store. A customer located in the USA will see products prices in US dollars, whereas a customer located in France will see the product prices displayed in euros.</p> <p>When this setting is disabled: The currency indicated in the setting “<i>Default/Fallback store currency</i>” will be used for all customers, regardless of their location.</p>
<p><i>Filter currencies enabled for your store</i></p>	<p>This setting allows you to restrict the set of currencies that are allowed for your store. SCD uses this information in addition to geolocation to determine the customer currency to use for display and for payment.</p> <p>Example: If this setting is set to only two currencies, USD and EUR, then only these two currencies will be selected by SCD. Customers in USA will see prices in USD; customers located in the euro zone will see prices in EUR; all other customer will see prices in the default currency specified in the setting “<i>Default/Fallback store currency</i>”</p> <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When this setting is set to “All”, all possible currencies are enabled. • If your store uses the SCD widget, only the currencies allowed by this setting will be included in currency selection list of the SCD widget.
<p><i>Default/Fallback store currency</i></p>	<p>This setting specifies the default currency to use for your store. This default currency will be selected for display if location based currency selection is not enabled (see setting “<i>Select currency based on user location</i>”) or if the currency corresponding to the user location is not in the list of enabled currencies for your store (see setting “<i>Filter currencies enabled for your store</i>”).</p> <p>The default value of this setting is to use the "Base Currency", which is the currency selected in the WooCommerce setting, as the default currency.</p>

Setting	Description
<i>Enable decimal numbers display</i>	<p>This setting enables the use of decimal numbers in prices display. If enabled you can use the setting “<i>Number of decimals</i>” to indicate the number of decimals to display.</p> <p>When this setting is enabled: Decimal numbers are used in the prices display, using the number of decimals specified in the setting “<i>Number of decimals</i>”</p> <p>When this setting is disabled: Prices are rounded up to the nearest integer before display.</p>
<i>Number of decimals</i>	<p>This setting determines the number of digits to display after the decimal point.</p>
<i>Multi roles based, webpages display currency</i>	<p>This setting enables features for the SCD multivendors variant. Users of the SCD multivendors variant should ensure to enable this setting.</p>

Other admin capabilities

Set custom price per currency for a given product

SCD allows you set a custom price of a product for a given currency. For instance a product can be set to a price in US Dollars of 100 USD and a price in euros of 150 EUR. A customer shopping from the USA will see the product price as 100 USD; a customer from the euro zone will see the same product at 150 EUR.

When a custom price by currency is set for a product, SCD uses directly the custom price set by the vendor instead of converting the base currency price.

To set a custom price by currency for a product:

- In the wordpress dashboard, open the Edit Product page for the product to edit
- Locate the rectangle “SCD – Set Currency per Product” in the Edit Product page and click inside the textbox to select the currency for which you want to specify a custom price

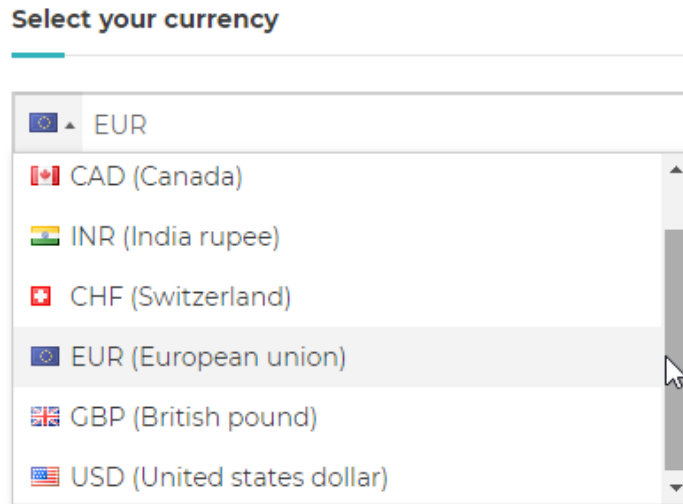

SCD Currency Selection Widget

SCD comes with an optional currency selection widget that you can include on your store pages to allow your customers to manually select the currency in which they want to view the product prices. The widget provides a drop-down list from which the end users can pick the currency.



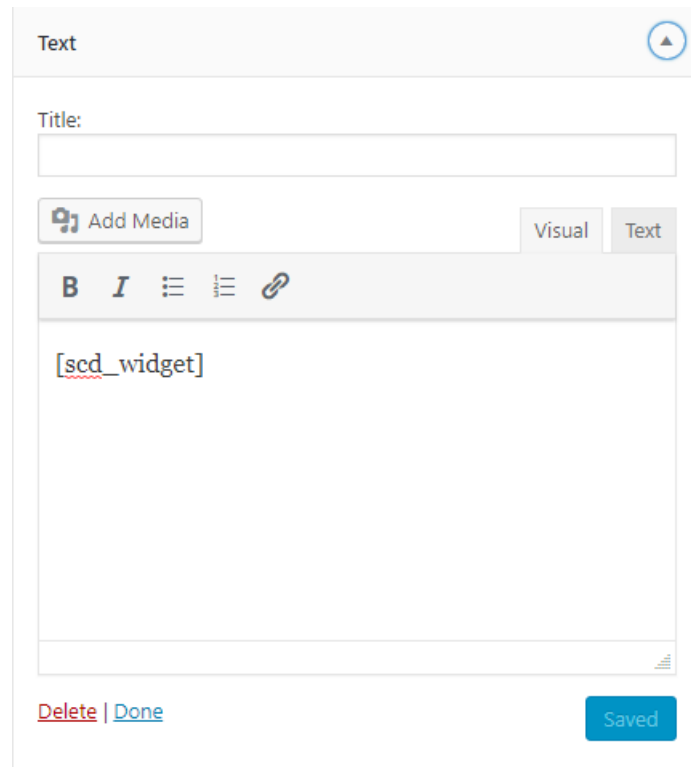
Installing the SCD widget

The SCD widget can be placed anywhere on the web page. To install the SCD widget:

- On your dashboard go to Appearance -> Widgets
- Select the widget named “SCD Widget” and move it to the area where you want to place the widget

Alternatively, the SCD widget can be installed using shortcodes. The widget shortcode is **[scd_widget]**

A quick way to add the SCD widget using the shortcode is to add a Text widget (using the Widgets menu on the wordpress dashboard) and set the text to **[scd_widget]**.



Note: Your theme may provide other ways of embedding shortcode widgets onto your web page. Please refer to your theme documentation for additional possibilities.

Setting the list of currencies available in the selection list

The list of currencies available in the SCD widget is determined by the admin setting “*Filter currencies enabled for your store*” located in the **Currencies Settings** tab of the SCD Admin settings menu:

- **When the setting is set to “All”** : all possible currencies can be selected using the SCD widget
- **When the setting is set to a fixed list of currencies:** only the currencies in the specified list can be selected using the SCD widget

SCD Integration with Marketplace Plugins (Dokan, WCFM, WC Vendors)

[Note: this feature is only available in the SCD multi-vendors variant product]

Capabilities provided by SCD for marketplaces

The SCD multi-vendors variant integrates with marketplace plugins such as Dokan, WCFM and WC Vendors to provide additional capabilities for marketplace admin and vendors:

Role	Features provided by SCD
<i>Marketplace Admin</i>	<p>The marketplace admin configures the SCD Admin settings described in the <i>SCD Admin Settings</i> section.</p> <p>For instance, the marketplace admin can use the SCD admin settings to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Configure the list of available currencies • Set custom exchange rates for currency conversions • Enable or Disable location based currency selection for customers of the marketplace • etc...
<i>Vendor</i>	<p>With SCD each vendor can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specify his own default currency • Use his default currency for setting his product prices. <p>For instance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vendor A can set Euros (EUR) as his default currency and define his product prices in EUR, • Vendor B can set British Pounds (GBP) as his default currency and define all its products prices in GBP.

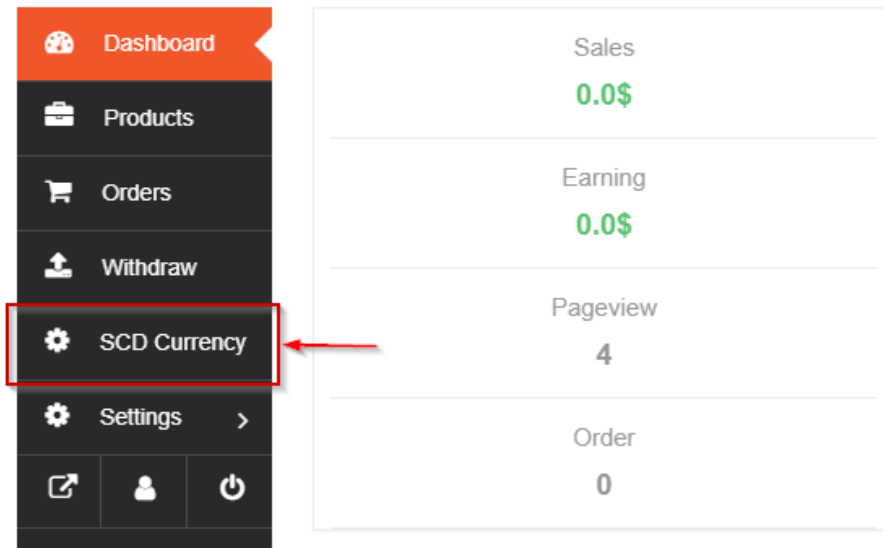
Role	Features provided by SCD
<i>Customer</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A customer visiting the marketplace will see all the products from all vendors in one single currency, determined based on the customer location and the SCD Admin settings.• SCD performs the conversions between the individual vendor currencies and the shopping currency of the customer.

Integration with DOKAN

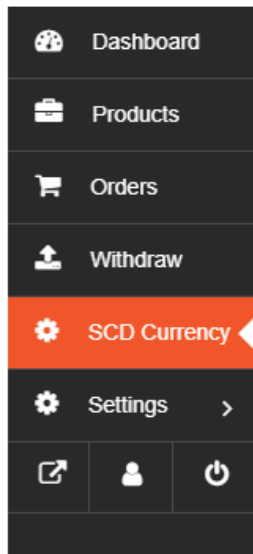
The integration with Dokan allows vendors to use the vendor dashboard to select a default currency and to enter their product prices in their selected default currency.

Vendor: Set default currency

From the vendor dashboard, select SCD Currency as illustrated



In the resulting menu, first select your default currency and save the change, then select in what currency you want to set the product prices in (the choices are base currency or default currency). Save the change.

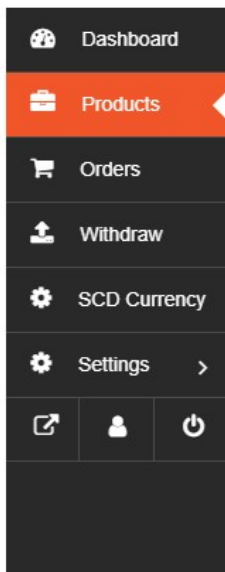

Vendor: Enter prices in selected currency

Once the default currency has been selected, use the dashboard menu for adding or editing product . The currency used for the product prices will now be the default currency you have selected (you can confirm it by checking the currency symbol next to the price textboxes).

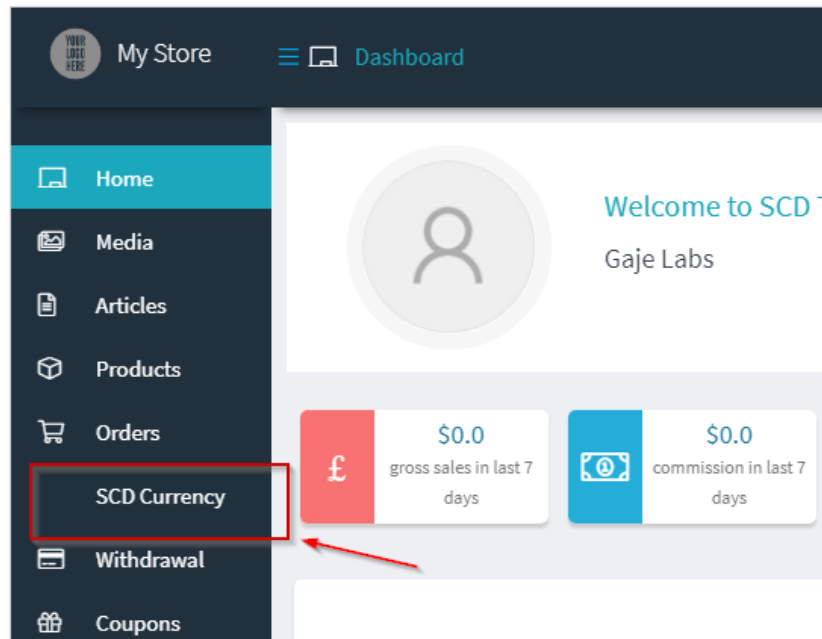

Integration with WCFM

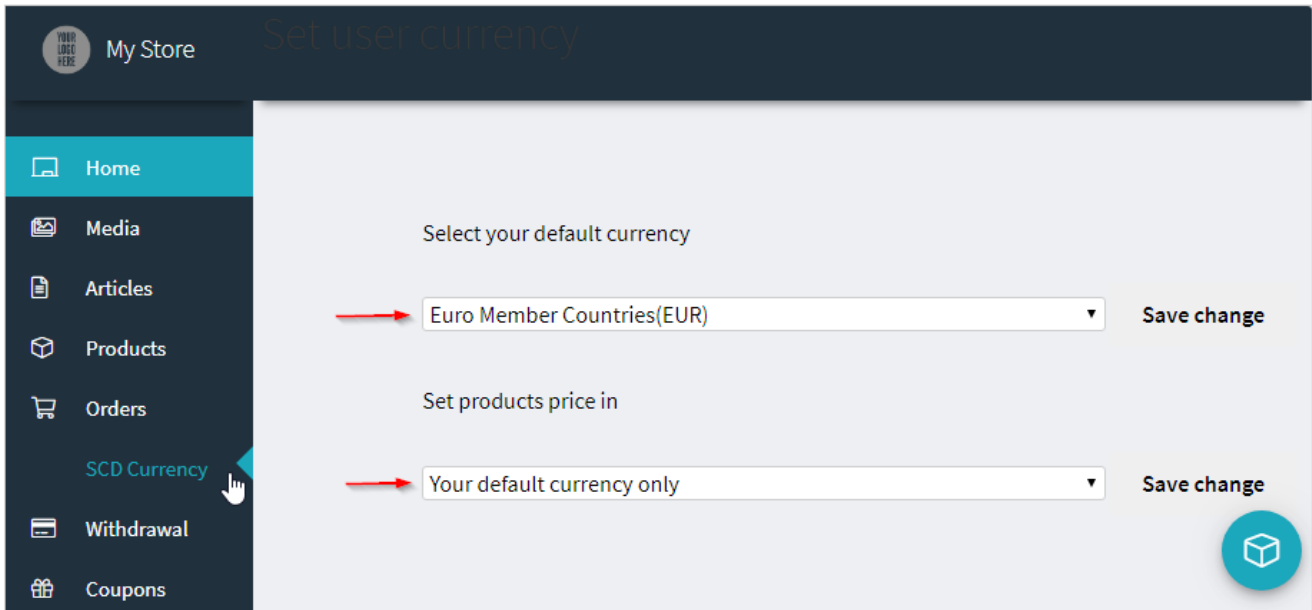
The integration with WCFM allows vendors to use the vendor dashboard to select a default currency and to enter their product prices in their selected default currency.

Vendor: Set default currency

From the vendor dashboard, select SCD Currency as illustrated

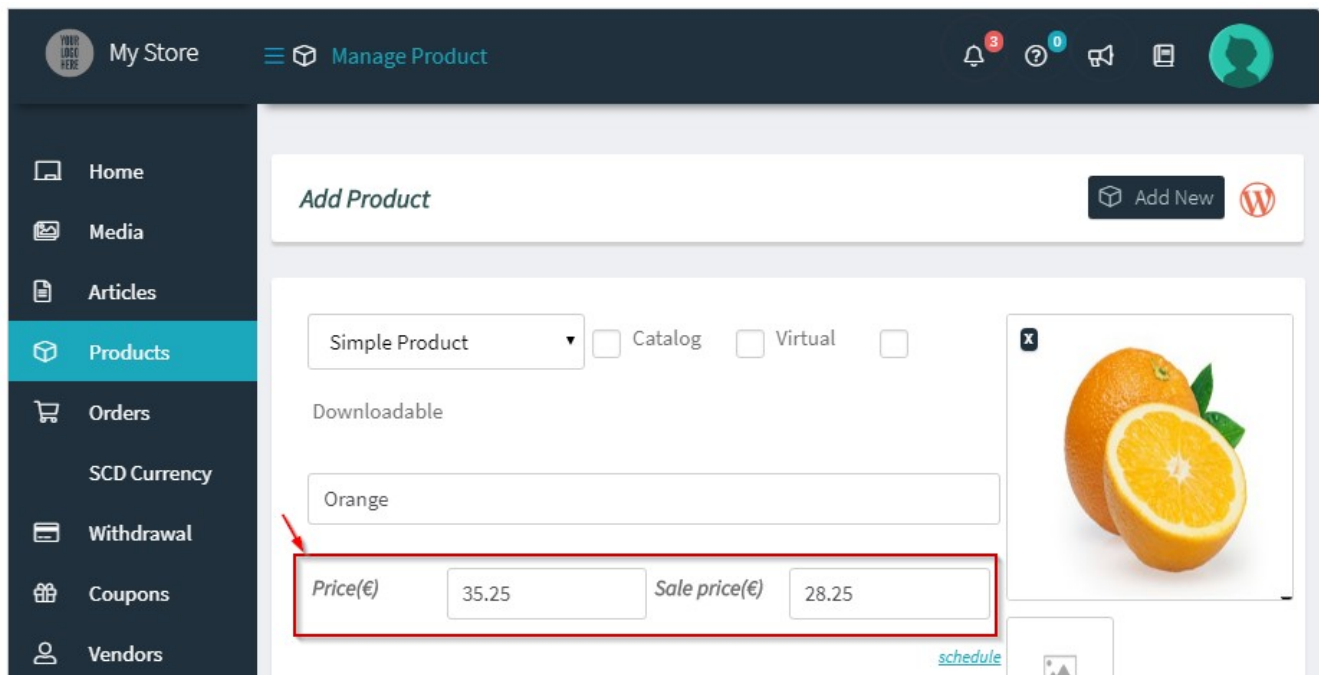


In the resulting menu, first select your default currency and save the change, then select in what currency you want to set the product prices in (the choices are base currency or default currency). Save the change.



Vendor: Enter prices in selected currency

Once the default currency has been selected, use the dashboard menu for adding or editing product. The currency used for the product prices will now be the default currency you have selected.



Integration with WC Vendors

The integration with WC Vendors allow vendors to specify a product price in a custom currency on the Product Edit page. Vendors of a WC Vendors marketplace can use the SCD feature “Set Custom Price Per Currency” to enter product prices in their currency.

Refer to Set custom price per currency for a given product for detailed description of this feature.
